The UT's natural resources shape its use, with forestry and recreation as dominant industries. While much of the land is actively managed for timber, many areas are undisturbed for 10 to 80 years at a time. A few small stores cater to the needs of local residents and visitors. Home-based businesses include construction contracting, auto repair and other services. The tourist industry includes lodging and dining facilities. Hiking, hunting and boating are long-time draws for the region. Snowmobile and ATV trails to destinations like the Nicatous Lodge have extended the season for some tourist attractions.
