

ROADS



There are about 20 miles of state highway and only 1 mile of U.S. Route 1 in the UT. Boat access to Graham Lake and ample, handy parking is provided here from Route 179.



Many miles of graveled roads in the UT used by automobiles in the summer, become the domain of snowmobiles in the winter. Year-round use of ATV's on roads and trails has increased.



The wide, gravel Stud Mill Road provides a 27-mile East-West thoroughfare through the Hancock County UT about 10 miles north of State Route 9 (also called "the Airline").



Private roads, some maintained by owner associations, are often restricted from public use by signs and gates.
