

SEASONAL DWELLINGS



The UT contains numerous vacation homes, both permanent and mobile. These dwellings can be used as a base for four-seasons of recreational activity and as hunting camps. Some have modern conveniences and easy access, while many are quite primitive and remote. Many are clustered along the shores of the area's pristine lakes and streams.

As in the rest of Hancock County, seasonal homes are subject to conversion to year-round use and back again, sometimes with little modification. It is therefore difficult to identify a dwelling's status by its attributes or location alone. The red house in T32 MD shown below is identified as "Ten Hill Farm" and may be the one year-round dwelling identified in that tract for 2000 census.
