Update from meeting with DOC – George Powell

- DOC range of options for local assistance
- Design requirements – handicap access
- Prioritization
 - Inland ponds
 - Motor boats
 - Recreational access
- Presented preliminary design
 - Boat launch up stream or downstream side of the wharf debated
 - Safety
 - Ice damage
 - Riparian rights (ownership of submerged lands)
- Funding
 - Setting aside \$150,000 for this project
 - LMF - \$10,000
 - Byway - \$42,000 + \$242,000

- Plan for the boat ramp appears to be quite large and might come to dominate the entire wharf
- Large boats – present some environmental impact
- Want to consider degree of access
 - What size boat
 - What kinds of uses
 - What regulations
- Interpretation
 - Historical Granite
